1- Course objectives and description

The Master's degree in Adapted Physical Activity and Health (APA-S) has been taught for more than 13 years and offers two programmes: one professional (IGAPAS) and the other research-based (MPSI). The objective of the IGAPA-S professional programme (Intervention and Management in APA-S) is to train managers able to design and implement innovative systems:

- based on the epistemological, methodological and ethical framework of APA,
- meeting the needs of target groups
- and contributing to the projects of the organisations in which they work.

At the end of the APA-S Master's degree, graduates have acquired scientific, professional and sporting skills, as presented in the RNCP file for the Master in Adapted Physical Activity and Health: <u>http://www.rncp.cncp.gouv.fr/grand-public/visualisationFiche?format=fr&fiche=21149</u>. This threefold expertise enables graduates to design, plan, steer and evaluate programmes for prevention, health education, support, rehabilitation, reinsertion, therapeutic education and insertion through adapted physical activity (APA), as well as projects to promote adapted physical activity in line with the establishment's project.

The objective of the MPSI programme is to prepare for further study at doctoral level for future professional insertion in a research context in the academic and/or industrial sectors.

2- Admission requirements and recommended skills

Validation of the first year of a master's degree in APA-S and the ability to present a professional project clearly, both orally and in writing, with a defined work placement location.

3- Organisation of the course

M1/M2 coordination:

The teaching aims are distinctly separate and form a progression between the two years of the course. The 2nd year focuses on the creation of APA-S services or enterprises. All classes and both professional dissertations to be produced contribute to forming APA-S developers.

4- Career opportunities and/or further study

The professional insertion surveys carried out with alumni show that 83.3% of graduates in the Master's in Sports Science specialising in IGAPA-S responding to the survey are in employment one year after completing the course. This high rate of employment indicates a very satisfactory professional insertion rate. The positions occupied concern the following professions: prevention project manager, APA coordinator, APA teacher, and APA development manager. Graduates integrate structures in the form of APA-S services within existing establishments, or business start-ups offering APA-S services.

5- Course assessment

Validation of the M2 requires the validation of both semesters. Validation of a semester requires the validation of the teaching units composing it, with a possible compensation of marks between teaching units, provided a minimum of 8/20 is achieved in each teaching unit.

No compensation may take place for the 'Project Management' (SPT2086M) and 'Professional Experience in APA-S' (SPT2093M) teaching units.
